

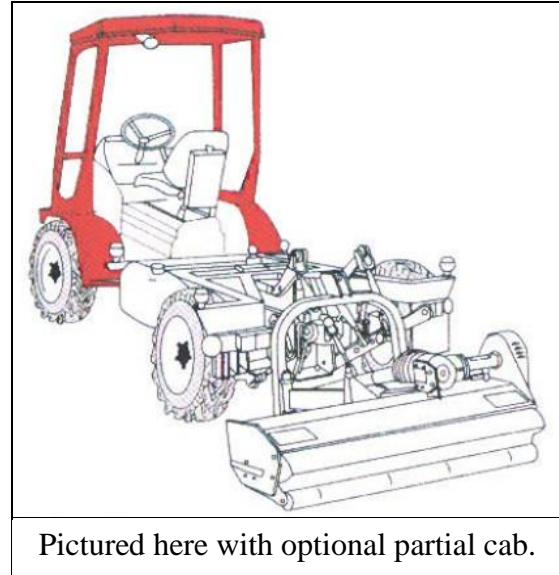

Versatility without Equal



In the restructuring of Agriculture in Italy, after the Second World War, a unique vehicle came into use; the "Transporter". It was a tractor and a truck in a single unit. In effect, a tractor with a stretched chassis so that a 3 way tipping dump bed could be fitted when hauling was needed. The rest of the time the 3 pt. and PTO allowed tillage, mowing, spraying, harvesting and hundreds of other farming tasks to be performed just as conventional tractors would.

One company continues to champion this approach and today offers (22) versions from 26 HP to 95 HP. These are ideal for the small land holder with diverse crops and mixed enterprises. This vehicle eliminates the need for multiple prime movers, that need to be maintained and that sit idle much of the time. The smallest of these hauls a ton or more with the traction and stability that only a true 4x4 tractor can offer. Multiple PTO options further extend the variety of tasks they can perform the year round.

Here is an opportunity for the newest farmer to have the advantage, to start out with the best tractor option from day one, without need to compromise. The 26 HP model C240AR with 3 way tipping bed and 3pt system sells for \$25,000.⁰⁰.
