An extremely versatile machine long used in construction and landscaping makes an ideal tool for the market gardener. This stand on, chariot like, loader is derived from skid steer loaders some are small enough to pass through a standard doorway yet can lift and carry many hundreds of pounds with bucket or forks. Turning around in its own length, it is ideal for cleaning stalls or pens and turning compost or spreading it. Mount forks and you can move pallets, harvest bins or hay.



Tiller is 42" wide and capable to till 6" deep. Features reversible tine rotation to clear jams and a reversible reel to allow tilling in either direction.

The hydraulic system that powers unit can also run all sorts of implements such as mowers, tillers, and augers. An optional electric power source can even give you 1500 watts to run electric hand tools as well. This versatile and tireless farm hand does the job with just 20 HP using little fuel, either gasoline or diesel. A propane version makes it ideal for greenhouse use as well.

The operator stands just a few inches off the ground so getting on and off is effortless. Fingertip controls are easy to learn and operate giving the smallest operator the strength and stamina of a "John Henry" of steel driving fame. Lifting capacities from 250 lbs. to 1100 lbs. are available to fit your application.
